1.	Follow
	"One day he got into a boat with his disciples, and he said to them, 'Let us go acros to the other side of the lake.' So they set out" (Luke 8:22)
2.	Don't
	"And behold, there arose a great storm on the sea, so that the boat was being swamped by the waves; but he was asleep." (v. 24)
3.	Rest
	"And they woke him and said to him, "Teacher, do you not care that we are perishing?'" (Mark 4:38)
4.	Trust
	"And he awoke and rebuked the wind and said to the sea, 'Peace! Be still!' And the wind ceased, and there was a great calm. He said to them, "Why are you so afraid Have you still no faith?" And they were filled with great fear and said to one another
