"Dear God: Will You Forgive Me?"

Psalm 51

¹Have mercy on me, O God, according to your steadfast love; according to your abundant mercy blot out my transgressions. ² Wash me thoroughly from my iniquity, and cleanse me from my sin!³ For I know my transgressions, and my sin is ever before me. ⁴ Against you, you only, have I sinned and done what is evil in your sight, so that you may be justified in your words and blameless in your judgment. ⁵ Behold, I was brought forth in iniquity, and in sin did my mother conceive me. ⁶ Behold, you delight in truth in the inward being, and you teach me wisdom in the secret heart. ⁷ Purge me with hyssop, and I shall be clean; wash me, and I shall be whiter than snow. 8 Let me hear joy and gladness; let the bones that you have broken rejoice. 9 Hide your face from my sins, and blot out all my iniquities. ¹⁰ Create in me a clean heart, O God, and renew a right spirit within me. ¹¹ Cast me not away from your presence, and take not your Holy Spirit from me. ¹² Restore to me the joy of your salvation, and uphold me with a willing spirit. ¹³ Then I will teach transgressors your ways, and sinners will return to you. ¹⁴ Deliver me from bloodquiltiness, O God, O God of my salvation and my tongue will sing aloud of your righteousness. ¹⁵ O Lord, open my lips, and my mouth will declare your praise. ¹⁶ For you will not delight in sacrifice, or I would give it; you will not be pleased with a burnt offering. ¹⁷ The sacrifices of God are a broken spirit; a broken and contrite heart, O God, you will not despise. ¹⁸ Do good to Zion in your good pleasure; build up the walls of Jerusalem; ¹⁹ then will you delight in right sacrifices, in burnt offerings and whole burnt offerings; then bulls will be offered on your altar.

Implied when asked of a superior:

"Have mercy on me, O God ... "

(Steps to <u>re-new</u> a right spirit and come clean spiritually)

1. Re .

"...according to your steadfast love...your abundant mercy..." (v. 1)

2. Re _____.

"For I know my transgressions, and my sin is ever before me..." (v. 3)

"I acknowledged my sin ...and I did not cover up my iniquity. I said, 'I will confess my transgressions to the LORD,' and you forgave the iniquity of my sin." (Psalm 32:5)

3. Re ______.

"Wash me thoroughly from my iniquity, and cleanse me from my sin!" (v. 3)

"Cleanse me...wash me...blot out all my iniquity." (vs. 7, 9)

"Create in me a clean heart, O God, and renew a right spirit within me..." (v. 10)

4 Re _____.

"Then I will teach transgressors your ways...and my mouth will declare your praise." (vs. 13, 15)

5. Re _____.

"The sacrifices of God are a broken spirit, a broken and contrite heat, O God, you will not despise." (v. 17)
